School Uniform Policy

Purpose

To help promote the image of the school and students' sense of pride in their appearance and identification with the school.

Objectives

1. Parents enrolling students are advised of the school's uniform.
2. Any change to the uniform is managed by a representative group set up by the principal, but not limited to parents and staff. This representative group makes recommendations to the Board which includes reasons for any change, details of proposed changes, proposed pricings, disposal of existing stock, and details of implementation. Any change requires the approval of the Board.
3. All students wear the standard sunhat during Term 1 and Term 4.
4. The uniform is attractive, practical, comfortable, affordable and easily laundered.
5. The uniform is available for purchase at the school office.
6. Students are expected to wear the school uniform every day including standard footwear or brown Roam sandals in the summer.
7. Students change into a sports uniform for physical education and for sports functions.
8. The principal and staff maintain regular checks on the wearing of the uniform.
